

TRAILS / CAMPING RULES

ENFORCEMENT OF THESE RULES AND COURTESIES SHOULD BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH MEMBER; HOWEVER, IN THOSE CASES WHERE AN ACCIDENT OCCURS WHICH BREAKS A RIDE RULE OR BI-LAW, CLUB OFFICERS WILL ENFORCE THE RIDE RULES AND BI-LAWS WITH APPROPRIATE ACTION.

- 1) ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL SIGN A "HOLD HARMLESS RELEASE" BEFORE ATTENDING A CLUB ACTIVITY.
- 2) A TRAIL GUIDE WILL BE APPOINTED FOR EACH ACTIVITY AND WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANSWERING ANY QUESTIONS THAT MAY COME UP AS WELL AS MONITORING THE ACTIVITY.
- 3) PARTICIPANTS DEMONSTRATING INTOXICATION OR UNRULY BEHAVIOR WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE ACTIVITY BY A CLUB OFFICER OR THE TRAIL GUIDE.
- 4) NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHILE RIDING OR HANDLING A HORSE.
- 5) FIREARMS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON RIDES.
- 6) HORSES THAT KICK MUST BE IDENTIFIED BY VISIBLE INDICATORS FOR FELLOW RIDERS: IE., A RED RIBBON IN THE TAIL.
- 7) STALLIONS AND UNRULY HORSES MUST BE TIED OR RESTRAINED AWAY FROM MAIN CAMPING AREA AND RIDING LOCATIONS.
- 8) OWNER OF ANY UNRULY HORSES MUST MOVE OR CONTAIN THEM IMMEDIATELY UPON REQUEST OF A CLUB OFFICER OR THE TRAIL GUIDE.
- 9) UPON MAKING/BREAKING CAMP OR DAY ACTIVITY, TREES MUST BE PROTECTED FROM ANIMALS WHICH CHEW BARK, ALL TRASH PICKED UP AND DISPOSED OF PROPERLY, ALL LOOSE HAY PICKED UP, HOLES FILLED AND LEVELED, MANURE SPREAD AND ALL FIRES TOTALLY PUT OUT.
- 10) A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST IS REQUIRED AT ALL FUNCTIONS.

TRAIL / CAMPING COURTESY

- 1) THE SENIOR CLUB OFFICER WILL DISPLAY A RIBBON, OR THE CLUB FLAG, AT THEIR CAMPSITE/ RIG FOR ANSWERING QUESTIONS.
- 2) PASS A FELLOW RIDER AT A WALK OR TROT. LET THEM KNOW YOU'RE PASSING.
- 3) DON'T TAILGATE
- 4) NO ROUGH RIDING. IF YOU WANT TO RACE OR RUN, DO SO AWAY FROM THE MAIN RIDING GROUP.
